

WINTERIZING IN-GROUNDS CHLORINE

1. Balance pH, Alkalinity, and Calcium Hardness.
2. Make sure pool bottom and sides are clean and free of debris.
3. Clean the sand using Strip-Kwik Filter Cleaner.
4. Shock with Winter Shock.
5. Add Winter Algaecide.
6. Circulate at least six hours (preferably overnight).
7. Winterize equipment:
 - a. Remove plugs from pump housing-there will usually be two.
 - b. Remove plug from Polaris Booster Pump.
 - c. Remove drain cap, sight glass, and pressure gauge from filter.
 - d. Place a Gizmo or plastic bottle in the skimmer(s).
 - e. Make sure all valves are in the open position (running parallel with the pipe).
 - f. Place multi-port valve on winterize or between any two settings.
 - g. Cover the pool.

** If you have a Nature2 unit, Frog unit, or heater there will be plugs to remove in each of them as well. Leave all valves open.
